Despite having a duty of care to their employees, 40% of businesses have historically had no visibility of their workers in the field²







- The timer expires and a red alert in the Alarm Receiving Centre is activated
- The Operator listens and assesses the red alert, tries to communicate with the user and follows the employers' bespoke escalation procedure
- The Operator escalates to emergency services or pre-defined contracts (as needed)
