

The following terms and conditions apply to the Vodafone Mobile Rugby Competition (the “Competition”). These terms and conditions apply in addition to the Vodafone General Competition. By entering the Competition, the “Entrant” agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions and agrees that the decisions of the Promoter are binding and final.

2. Competition winners entering between the 3rd of February and the 10th of February will win a pair (two) tickets for the Ireland v Italy Six Nations Rugby match taking place in the Aviva Stadium on the 14th of February 2026 (the “Prize”).
